## CLASS 6 – CERAMICS

**Bisque that is purchased must be stated on entry tag. Otherwise greenware must be cleaned by entrant. There will be no felt on bottoms with the exception of weighted chess pieces or bookends. Pieces with felt on bottoms, other than exceptions, will be disqualified by judges.**

1. Underglaze
2. Glaze
3. Overglaze
4. Stains
5. Chalks or Chalking
6. Originals in clay (hand thrown, coil, wheel, sculptures)
7. Groupings (5 or more pieces)  
Example: chess sets
8. Dry brushing
9. Miniatures (2 inches or less)
